Product Description:

NR-13404 is a shuttle vector that can be used for gene expression in either *Escherichia coli* or *Mycobacterium tuberculosis*. The pMCSU2 vector contains origins of replication for both organisms, *Escherichia coli* bacteriophage λ *att*R sites, a *Mycobacterium BCG* hsp60 promoter region, as well as the genes that confer resistance to kanamycin (Km), hygromycin B (Hyg) and chloramphenicol (Cm). The recommended antibiotic concentrations in culture are 50 µg/mL Km or 200 µg/mL Hyg.

Material Provided:

Each vial contains approximately 1 μ g of plasmid DNA in 10 mM Tris-HCl, pH ~ 8.0. The concentration is shown on the Certificate of Analysis.

Packaging/Storage:

NR-13404 was packaged aseptically in screw-capped cryovials. The product is provided frozen on dry ice and should be stored at -20°C or colder immediately upon arrival. Freeze-thaw cycles should be minimized.
