Antibody Class: IgG<sub>1</sub>

Antibody Designation (Original Designation): IT-46 (HBT10) Monoclonal antibody to *Mycobacterium tuberculosis*, strain H37Rv secreted L-alanine dehydrogenase (Ald; 40 kDa protein) was produced in cell culture using a B cell hybridoma generated by the fusion of myeloma cells with immunized mouse splenocytes.

### **Material Provided:**

Each vial contains approximately 500  $\mu L$  of NR-13651 provided as cell culture supernatant.

#### Packaging/Storage:

NR-13651 was packaged aseptically in screw-cap cryovials. The product is provided frozen on dry ice and should be stored at -80°C or colder immediately upon arrival. Freeze-thaw cycles should be avoided.
