Provided:	1 ml cell-free virus. Titer: $10^{8.7}$ TCID ₅₀ /ml. Infects HeLa and other vertebrate cells.
Cloning Vector:	Vaccinia virus, strain WR.
Description:	The plasmid pMNSC11-14 was used to construct the recombinant virus, vMN462. This construct contains the full-length HIV-1 _{MN} env gene under control of the vaccinia virus P7.5 promoter.
Special Characteristics:	The <i>env</i> protein, gp160, is expressed in cells infected with this virus. However, cleavage to gp120 and gp41, and syncytium formation are not observed. Sterility: Negative for mycoplasma, bacteria and fungi. Cloning Site: Vaccinia virus thymidine kinase gene.
Recommended Storage:	-70degreeC.
