Staphylococcus aureus subsp. aureus, Strain JE2, Transposon Mutant NE1763 (SAUSA300_1480)

Product Description: Staphylococcus aureus (S. aureus) subsp. aureus, transposon mutant NE1763 was derived from S. aureus subsp. aureus, strain JE2. Mutagenesis occurred through the use of the *mariner*-based transposon bursa aurealis resulting in an erythromycin-resistant deletion strain of JE2. S. aureus subsp. aureus, transposon mutant NE1763 was created by disruption of SAUSA300_1480, which encodes for a putative TraG membrane protein. Strain JE2 is a plasmid-cured derivative of strain LAC that was isolated in 2002 from a skin and soft tissue infection of an inmate in the Los Angeles County Jail in California, USA.



¹NR-48305 was produced by inoculation of the deposited material into Tryptic Soy broth with 5 μg/mL erythromycin and incubated for 24 hours at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere. Broth inoculum was added to Tryptic Soy agar with 5 μg/mL erythromycin kolles which were grown 24 hours at 37°C in an aerobic atmosphere to produce this lot.

³Prior to initiating work, it is recommended that the presence and location of the transposon is confirmed. Gene specific primers should be paired with either the "Upstream" primer (5'-CTCGATTCTATTAACAAGGG-3') for transposons in the "plus" orientation or the "Buster" primer (5'-GCTTTTTCTAAATGTTTTTTAAGTAAATCAAGTAC-3') for transposons in the "minus" orientation.
